



Avignon 2008

Barossa red wines blended from Grenache, Shiraz and Mourvedre are world famous for their superior depth and length of flavour, whilst still remaining textured and subtle on the palate.

The 2008 has been blended to create a wine of great character. A fine drink now, which will develop nicely over the next 5 years... decant to appreciate it's full complexity.

Colour:

bright cherry deepening to ruby

Nose:

Upfront fennel and plum open out to perfumed musky blueberry aromas

Palate:

Mulberry, blackberry, musk sticks, and liquorice underpinned by charry brown cardamom and hints of black pepper. Good mineralality and tangy acidity with length on the palate.

Notes: Grenache (46%) 70 year old vines, Shiraz (40%) 65 year old vines, Mourvedre (14%) 43 year old vines. All Kaesler estate vineyards.
